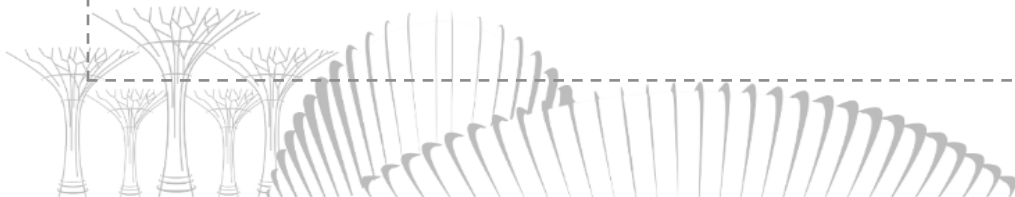
The following admission and programme rates apply:
