HOW TO USE OUR GO GREEN SG CHAMPION ACTIVITY BOOKLET?

1. Green habits made easy

The activity book introduces concepts like energy conservation, heat resilience, coastal protection, and food resilience through fun activities like fill-in-the-blanks, colouring and matching the correct answers. You are encouraged to do the activities with your children and explain simple changes they can make to cope with climate change!



2. Deepen understanding with engaging prompts

To further engage them, ask your children simple questions like: "How can we save electricity at home?", or "How do we stay cool when it is very hot outside?"

3. Spark meaningful conversations

Engage in sustainability conversations with your children based on relevant content from the activity book. This helps them learn about the importance of being responsible stewards of the environment.

4. Bond while making a difference

Bond with your children by taking part in sustainability-related activities (e.g. upcycling, outdoor gardening, community clean-up) and encouraging them to adopt green habits (e.g. saving energy in the classroom and at home and asking their family members to support local produce).

We also encourage you to lead by example by practising eco-friendly and sustainable habits!
